

**Special Town Meeting Warrant
January 9, 2017**

TO: Hartley Mowatt, a resident of the Town of Paris, in the County of Oxford, State of Maine:

GREETINGS:

In the name of the State of Maine you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of the Town of Paris in said County and State, qualified to vote in town affairs, to meet at the Paris Town Office, 33 Market Square, South Paris, Maine on the 9th day of January, 2017 at 6:30 o'clock in the evening, then and there to act on the following articles, to wit:

ARTICLE 1: To elect a Moderator to preside at said meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To see if the Town will ratify the use of \$168,319 from surplus to cover overdrafts to Town accounts for fiscal year ending June 30, 2016.*

ARTICLE 3: To see what sum of money, if any, the Town will vote to appropriate from surplus to the Town unclassified **Contingency Account**.


