What products should I bring to the Collection?

Look for the words: Caution, Warning, Poison, Corrosive, Toxic, Volatile, Flammable or Danger on the label.

How Do I Dispose of Hazardous Waste?

- What is a unit? One unit equals up to 5 gallons of liquid waste or up to 20 pounds of dry waste or a combination.)
- Residents from participating towns may be bring up to 2 units to the Depot at no charge. More than 2 units may be subject to a per unit charge of \$29.00.
- Residents from non-participating towns are subject to a per unit fee and must pay the contractor in cash or by check. (\$29.00 per unit)
- Keep hazardous waste in original container DO NOT MIX. If leaking wrap in plastic bag and place in a separate box.
- Place materials in a secure box.
- Place secured box in trunk or truck bed.
- Remain in your vehicle.
